

## **EDITORIAL POLICY**

*Law & Policy* publishes innovative, peer-reviewed articles that promote interdisciplinary dialogue about the governmental and regulatory activities of both state and non-state actors. Encompassing approaches that interrogate law and governance within a broad range of policy domains, the journal disseminates scholarship that is international and comparative, methodologically diverse, and critically challenging. Manuscripts are encouraged that provide creative theoretical overviews, as well as discussions of empirical research. Major considerations for publication include originality of insight into the legal process, relevance of policy issues addressed, and the use of appropriate methodology.

## **MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION**

Submit manuscripts <https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/lawpol>. \* Manuscripts must not have been published already, or be under consideration by another publication.

**Submission Format:** Manuscripts should be double-spaced, 12-pt Times New Roman font, with 1-inch margins (paper copies should be single sided), with numbered pages.

**What to Submit:** A single document must contain all text, with author-date citations, including an abstract (up to 100 words), endnotes (not footnotes) for supplementary comments, references with separate sections for legal authorities, and any appendices, tables, or figures. Remove all self-identifying information about the author(s), acknowledgments, embedded identifying information, etc., and all headers and footers.

A separate document or cover letter should include: a title page with all authors' names; the correspondence author's e-mail and mailing/postal address, telephone and fax numbers; and a biographical statement (of up to 50 words) for each author.

The manuscript should be carefully checked for errors before it is submitted for publication. Authors are responsible for the accuracy of quotations and extracts, for supplying complete and correct references, and for obtaining permission where needed to cite another author's material.
